"The dual Minkowski problem"

Abstract:

The (classical) Minkowski problem asked for sufficient and necessary conditions such that a finite Borel measure on the sphere is the surface area measure of a convex body. Its solution, based on works by Minkowski, Aleksandrov and Fenchel & Jessen, is one of the centerpieces of the classical Brunn-Minkowski theory. There are two farreaching extensions, the L_{ρ} -Brunn-Minkowski theory and the dual Brunn-Minkowski theory. In the talk we will discuss the analog of the (classical) Minkowski problem within the dual Brunn-Minkowski theory, i.e., the characterization problem of the dual curvature measures. These measures were recently introduced by Huang, Lutwak, Yang and Zhang and are the counterparts to the surface area measures within the dual theory.
